Destini eyes RM1b order book by 2017

SHAH ALAM: Destini Bhd, an integrated engineering solutions provider, is vying for RM1 billion order book for the group by early next year.

Its group managing director Datuk Rozabil Abdul Rahman said as at March 31, the group's order-book stood at RM650 million, of which the biggest contributor comprised marine contracts.

"Looking at our commercial aviation expansion, I anticipate it will exceed RM1 billion (worth of) contracts by early next year," he said after the company's annual general meeting, here, yesterday.

Rozabil said there were two divisions that Destini was active in currently, namely marine and commercial aviation, that contributed positively to the group.

"Over the next few years, we aim to strengthen our position with a wider scope of services and expand

our reach to be a leading maintenance, repair and overhaul (MRO) service provider for commercial airlines in the Asean region," he said.

In commercial aviation, he said the company had initiated a component MRO contract for AirAsia and would expand to other services by the third quarter of this year, and it was also in talks with other airlines.

Destini was also expected to expand its capabilities in rail MRO services, under the land transport division, he said.

"We have planned to go into rail MRO since last year but did not make any announcements. However, this year we are ready to go all out on the rail industry, with bidding for RM250 million worth of tenders for rail MRO and supply of equipment," he said.

The status of its venture into rail services would be announced in this quarter, he said. **Bernama**
